

Technical check of foreign model airplanes above 7 kg Before flying in Denmark.



The responsible safety officer at the hosting club must ensure that a foreign aircraft can meet the following requirements before this is allowed to fly in Denmark.

- The plane must be without larger damages and shall be working properly.
- All parts of the plane must be securely attached.
- The strength of the attachment of wings must be adequate.
- The strength of the attachment of control-surfaces must be adequate.
- The strength of the attachment of wingtubes/spars must be adequate.
- The strength of the attachment of motor(s) must be adequate.
- The strength of servos must be adequate.
- The size/capacity of batteries including wiring dimensions for receiver and ignition must be appropriate.
- Propellers shall be without any damages.
- The center of gravity must be adequate with the manual of the model.
- A range-check of 200 meters on full transmitting strength without losing signal.

Finally, all foreign model airplanes driven by a jet engine or weighing more than 7 kg, shall be insured by the owner and the insurance must be valid in Denmark. Proof of this must be shown before any flying can be allowed.
